#### **Branch Meetings:**

Are held on the first Tuesday of every second month which are: February, April, June, August, October and December. Meetings are held in the Avoca Room at the Sugarland Tavern, 52 Johnston Street, Avoca, Bundaberg. The meetings commence at 6.30pm sharp. Feel free to arrive earlier to enjoy a meal and beverages.

### **Thursday Rides:**

We have a ride to various destinations around the area every Thursday of the year unless notified otherwise.

Thursday rides will normally depart from the River Cruz car park on Quay Street at 9.30am. Meet at 9.00am or earlier for coffee and food. There is usually a riders meeting in the carpark at 9.15 to discuss the days destination.

If we are departing from a different venue or at a different time the details will be advised by email, on our Facebook page and on our website.

The destination is usually decided on the ride the previous week. Depending on weather conditions, interest, etc there may be a last-minute change. The 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of each month ride is usually to a destination which does not have food available so BYO lunch. Most other times there will a cafe or pub to eat at but feel free to bring your own food on any ride.

If you want a pre ride coffee or feed, we have a table booked at River Cruz Cafe.

### Sunday Rides:

## 10/04/2025 Thursday Ride to Mount Perry
